Important Notification

EDIUS 9 requires SHA-2 hash algorithm code signing to be active Grass Valley hardware driver. All versions of Windows 7, Windows 8.1 and Windows 10 already support SHA-2 code signing, but if you are running Windows 7, you will need to install Security Updates.

SHA-2 code signing requires installation of Windows 7 updates in order to use Grass Valley hardware. There are following two ways to support SHA-2 code signing:

Obtain the latest update (recommended)

Obtain the latest update from Windows Update

Install two security updates

Install TWO Security Updates on Windows 7. Download stand-alone installer files from Microsoft website then run the installer. They MUST be installed in the following order.

2. [Security Update for Windows 7 for x64-based Systems \(KB3033929\)](#)

If they have not been installed, installed Grass Valley hardware may not work.

Update History

The following issues are fixed or improved in this version:

EDIUS

- Improved Optical Flow quality for better slow motion video
- Timeline track patch displayed incorrectly in 32ch audio project
- EDIUS Germany UI is incorrectly drawn if DPI settings is set to 125%
- Drop rectangle does not appear while drag & drop a clip
- Support to work display progress on task bar icon for partial rendering
- EDIUS start up splash displays incorrect number of logical processors on certain system (SFDC00633041)
- EDIUS crashes while running project auto save
- Line noise appears at Border Wipe applied part (SFDC00634170)
- Brightness level slightly goes down if screen keyer applied (SFDC00634726)
- EDIUS crashes when opening Chroma key dialog after changing project resolution
- Quick Titler text object moves if grid is enabled (SFDC00636583)
- "Go to next marker" and "Go to previous marker" are not working as expected when marker row regained focus
- Go to previous Marker does not work in Marker Palette on certain steps
- Unnecessary Undo information is recorded on certain Marker Palette operation
- Disc Burner file selection dialog is incorrectly drawn if DPI settings changed (SFDC00646196)

Mync

- Storyboard comment is lost from exported Storyboard name
- Incorrect Start/End timecode appear on XDCAM EX spanned clip
- Mync crashes when using Ctrl + T keyboard shortcut
- Fails to export Storyboard XML if HDR clip is placed
- Incorrect TC mode appears when EDIUS imports FCP xml exported by Mync
- Facebook uploader is no longer available due to end of support of Facebook desktop application

Restrictions after Uninstallation of QuickTime for Windows

The following functionality will be lost if QuickTime is uninstalled:

Still Image File Formats: Flash Pix; Mac Pict; QuickTime Image

MOV Video File Formats: M4V or some MOV file formats

MOV Video File Formats: 3GP; 3G2 (export)

Audio File Formats: MOV (other than Linear PCM and AAC); QuickTime Audio

Corrupting footage on RED clip preview in draft mode

If certain RED clip is previewed in draft mode (either 1/8 or 1/16 size), corrupting footage occurs. Choose 1/4 or higher resolution (including Full mode) for workaround.
